

Survival kits — donors may place these items together in a reusable bag or donate individual items:

- A thermometer;
- First-aid kit;
- Postage stamps (10 per bag);
- Envelopes;
- A flashlight;
- Acetaminophen and children's acetaminophen;
- An alarm clock;
- 60-watt light bulbs;
- A wallet;
- New pillows; and
- Night lights.

Bucket basics — donors may place these items together in a small trash can or individually:

- Sponges;
- Paper towels;
- Shower curtains;
- Laundry detergent; and,
- Dish soap.

Welcome baskets for children — donors may place these items together in basket or bag or donate individual items:

- Hair ties and ribbons;
- Coloring books and crayons;
- Craft kits;
- Small toys and dolls;
- Pens, pencils, and notebooks; and
- Socks.

Welcome baskets for teens:

- Small board games;
- Hair accessories;
- A pocket dictionary;
- Pens, pencils, and notebooks;
- Soaps;
- Lotions;
- An alarm clock; and
- A yo-yo.

Welcome baskets for adults:

- Soaps
- Lotions;
- Shampoo;
- A comb and a brush;
- Tissues
- A toothbrush and toothpaste;
- Deodorant;
- A shaving kit
- First-aid items; and
- A wallet
