

We have adopted our pets and encourage others to do the same





-Most years our vacations with extended family are fishing in Minnesota. One of our favorite places was Yellowstone and we can't wait to revisit some of these places with our children one day.












-We rent a cabin and pontoon to go out on the lake several times a day rain or shine
